

ENGLISH

In their English learning, the children will focus on the fiction text of 'The Disgusting Sandwich' by Gareth Edwards. The children will use these texts to write different genres and focus on the writing skills of: a diary entry, instructional text and setting description. The children will continue to build up their knowledge of grammar and spelling patterns to help with their word and sentence formation. They will apply this in their writing lessons and across the other subjects of the curriculum.

Year one will continue to complete a daily phonics lesson in preparation for the phonics screening check in June.

PSHE

This half term, the children will continue to learn about economic wellbeing. They will build on last half terms learning about money, keeping money safe and how people can save money. They will then move on to think about how to keep themselves safe and their changing bodies.

PE

Each Monday, the children will focus on a unit called 'Run, Jump, Throw'. They will begin to link running and jumping and learn and refine a range of running skills. Within this unit, they will also develop throwing techniques to throw over longer distances.

On their Wednesday lesson, they will be focusing on their second unit of dance. The children will continue to develop their skills by building simple movement patterns which include a cannon, rounds and use of space.

MATHS

The year one maths learning will focus on multiplication and division; place value (within 100); money; and time. The children will also learn about fractions, where they will be introduced to half and quarter. They will focus on recognising and finding half and a quarter of both objects and shapes. The children will also look at position and direction where they will describe left and right; forwards and backwards; and above and below.

Throughout their maths lessons, the children will be encouraged to use mathematical talk. The children will develop their skills in explaining answers which will show their understanding of the mathematical skill. The children will take part in a 15 minute mastering number lesson which promotes the development of good number sense. Over time, children will gain fluency in calculation and gain confidence and flexibility with number.

SCIENCE

This half term the year 1, will be learning about plants. The children identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees. The children will be working scientifically; using magnifying glasses to observe and name plant parts and sort leaves into groups based on appearance.

COMPUTING

Animated stories is our topic for summer. Children will create e-books, add animation to a story, add sound to a story, including voice recordings and music that they have composed.

GEOGRAPHY

In geography this half term, year 1 will be exploring human and physical geographical features. The children will learn about Shanghai and use their knowledge of geographical features to describe and compare it to the United Kingdom.

RE

In RE the children will be exploring how people with similar religious and world views share and celebrate their beliefs. They will explore and compare a range of religious and non religious celebrations.

MUSIC

This half term, the children will be receiving lessons from Mrs Rowstron. They will be singing with actions, exploring the ocarina and learning about some of the interrelated dimensions of music.

ART

This half term the children will be exploring paper-based 3D art forms, focusing on techniques like rolling paper tubes, shaping paper strips, and constructing imaginative sculptures. They will develop skills in creating 3D structures and apply painting skills in three-dimensional art, enhancing their understanding of form and construction.
